


### Documentation Report


The NSS volunteers actively took participation in the documentation process and completed it within the two days.






### Home Energy Audit

### INAGRAUTION OF "AARUNYA 2016"




Day 2(27/12/2016)
















### DAY 3 (28/12/2016)

Ice breaking session, mentally disabled kids camp 'NIRACHARTHU' visit and home energy audit class





### DAY 4(29/12/2016)


Home energy audit at surrounding homes, talk on SOCIAL ENGINEER and KALASANDHYA by local people.

Here follows the report of each activity.


### 24/09/2016 (NSS DAY)

protecting the land and nature.




### 28/9/2016 - Energy Saving




### 27/9/2016 - Environmental Protection

Outcome: Create awareness about the environmental protection among the villagers.






Outcome: NSS volunteers take initiated to create awareness about the importance of our water sources to be neat and clean and also about rain water harvesting.



# 1/10/2016 - Lifestyle disenses and remedial measures


Objective: To create awareness on modern lifestyle diseases and remedial measures




Objective: To create an awareness on the effects of drugs and alcohol.


Objective: To celebrate NSS foundation day or NSS day and motivating NSS volunteers to do more responsible to themselves and towards the society.
